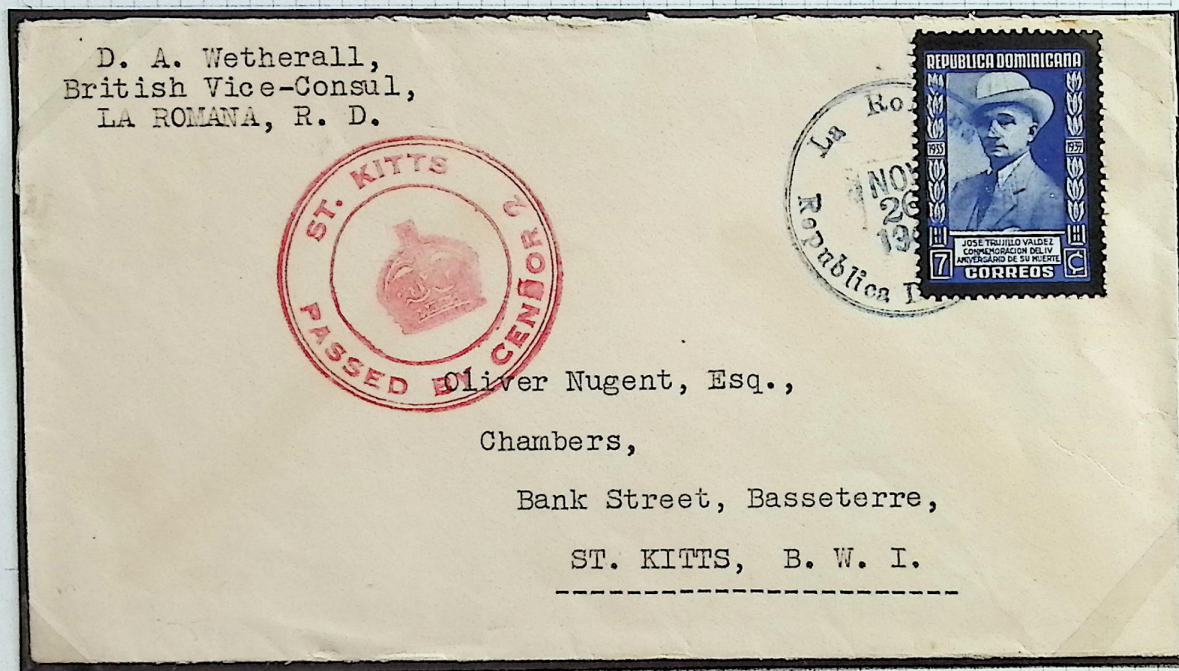

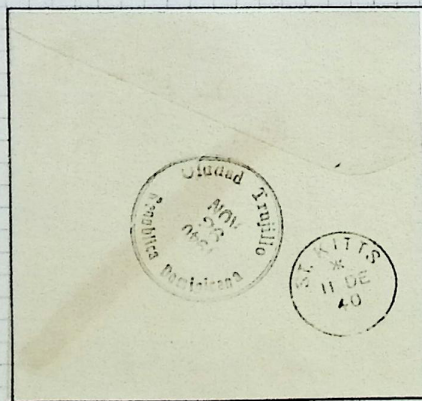
Cover from Dominican Republic to St Kitts, B.W.I.

Letter opened, and endorsed with cachet by St Kitts postal censor.



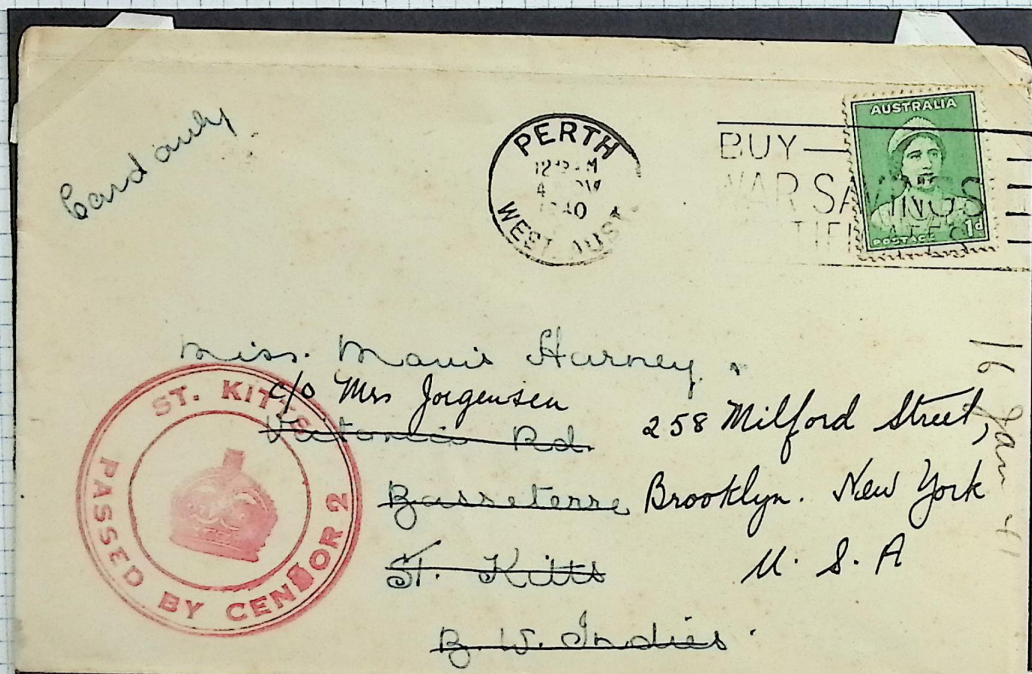

Cover Perth, Australia to St Kitts.

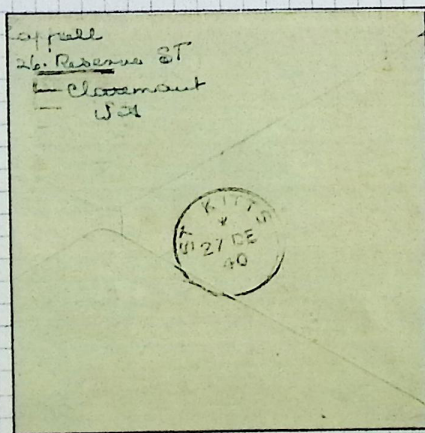
Postmarked, Perth, West Aust, 4-11-1940.
