

EARLY TRINIDAD COVERS

When the BWISC published the book *TRINIDAD – A Philatelic History to 1913* by Marriott, Medlicott and Ramkissoon, the final Appendix listed all early covers known to us at the time. The listing included all covers bearing imperforate adhesives up to and including 1860 as well as covers bearing perforated stamps to 1859. This list is on the BWISC website (bwisc.org) and has links to all the images that we have in our possession.

Of course, this listing was always going to be far from complete; any viewer who possesses a cover meeting the above criterion is asked to send to peterf@bwisc.org a scanned image (300dpi min) of the front and rear of the cover, preferably on a dark background. Also, some of the linked images are far from ideal; it may be that there is only a portion of the cover available from an auction catalogue, maybe the image is of poor resolution. Either way, we need better images and only you can help. Thank you.

TRS02020 27 August 1851	From Port of Spain to Bristol, delivered on 24 September, after 29 days at sea. (1d) purple-brown (SG2) for the local fee tied by '1' (Type 0.1b), charged on arrival 1 shilling. {Kanai, Addiss}
TRS0203028 August 1851	From Port of Spain to San Fernando. (1d) purple-brown (SG2) tied by '1' (Type 0.1b), used on large part wrapper with early date 'AU 28 1851'. {Hurlock, Marriott, Pitts}
TRS02040 4 September 1851	From San Fernando to Port of Spain. Franked with a single (1d) purple-brown (SG2). Backstamped with the datestamp sent in 1840 and used on covers with adhesives only for a month. Stamp cancelled '2' (Type 0.1a). {Addiss}
TRS02050 8 September 1851	(1d) purple-brown (SG2) on cover. {Seybold}
TRS02060 11 September 1851	From San Fernando addressed to Mrs. Stewart, Stirlingshire, Scotland. (1d) purple-brown (SG2) postmarked '2' (Type 0.1a). Cover showing unframed 'CR' (Caledonian Railways) in red. {Willard, Charlton Henry, Marriott, Spink (21 October 2004), Harmers (24 March 2011)}

TRS05060 13 March 1852	From Port of Spain to Paris, landed at Calais on 6 April. Franked with (1d) lilac (greenish grey) (SG5), cancelled by '1' (Type 0.1b), rated on arrival '30 décimes'. TRS03018 7 April 1852	Entire from Port of Spain to Greenock (Scotland), addressed to John Neill, franked with (1d) blue (light) (SG3); rated at 1s in manuscript and cancelled '1' (Type 0.1b). {Grosvenor (20 May 2010)}
TRS02300 12 April 1852	Entire headed 'Chaguanas' to Joseph Boissière at Port of Spain. Franked with single (1d) purple-brown full right marginal copy (SG2) indistinctly cancelled. Cover endorsed 'Fav;' by Mr. Surle. {Heathcote}
TRS03020 12 April 1852	(1d) blue (light) (SG3) on cover from San Fernando to John Neill, Greenock. Entire rated 1s, stamp cancelled by the rare '2' (small figure) (Type 0.1a). Trinidad double-arc datestamp on reverse, and arrival datestamps. {Carson}
TRS03030 14 April 1852	(1d) blue (light) (SG3) on cover from Port of Spain to Greenock. Stamp cancelled '1' (Type 0.1b). Trinidad double-arc datestamp on reverse, and arrival datestamps.
TRS03040 28 April 1852	(1d) blue (light) (SG3) on cover from Port of Spain to Greenock. Stamp cancelled '1' (Type 0.1b). Trinidad double-arc datestamp on reverse, and on arrival, datestamps (London 23 May and Greenock the 24th).

Backstamped with the datestamp sent on 31 October 1851 (set with '5' under date), and in transit at St. Joseph (Type 0.1a) with '3' (small figures).

TRS03200 25 July 1852	(1d) blue (light) (SG3) on cover from Port of Spain to Paris. Stamp cancelled '1' (Type 0.1b), and red framed 'Colonies/Art. 13'. {Victoria (29 November 2012)}
TRS03210 26 July 1852	From Port of Spain addressed to J. Neill at Greenock, Scotland, delivered on 6 September. An entire paying the local fee of one penny with a single (1d) blue (light) (SG3), cancelled '1' (Type 0.1b) and rated 1 shilling to be paid on arrival.
TRS03220 7 August 1852	From Port of Spain addressed to J. Neill at Greenock, Scotland, arrived on 7 September. An entire paying the local fee of one penny with a single (1d) blue (light) (SG3), cancelled '1' (Type 0.1b) and rated 2 shillings to be paid on arrival.
TRS03230 9 August 1852	From Port of Spain to Greenock, Scotland, addressed to John Neill. A prepaid entire paying the local fee of one penny, franked with a single (1d) deep blue (salvaged) (SG3), cancelled '1' (Type 0.1b). Rated 2 shillings to be paid on arrival.
TRS03240 21 August 1852	From (?) locally addressed to Port of Spain, (1d) deep blue (salvaged) (SG3) indistinctly cancelled. {Marriott}

TRS13010 16 September 1852	From Port of Spain to Philadelphia, in transit at New York on 18 October (33 days later ?). (1d) blue from the first lithographic printing (SG13). Charged '7 cents' for postage due on arrival, cover bearing on front large circular 'New York – Ship – Pct. 18 – 7'. {Hurlock, Harmer (4 April 1967, Chan)}

TRS03270 18 September 1852	From Port of Spain to Barbados, arrived the 27th. Franked with single (1d) blue (light) (SG3), cancelled '1' (Type 0.1b). {Turner}
TRS03280 24 September 1852	From Port of Spain to Greenock, Scotland, addressed to John Neill. An entire paying the local fee of one penny with a single (1d) deep blue (salvaged) (SG3), cancelled '1' (Type 0.1b). Rated 1 shilling to be paid on arrival.
TRS03290 25 September 1852	From Port of Spain addressed to David Kennedy in New York. Franked with single (1d) deep blue (salvaged) (SG3). In transit at St. Thomas and backstamped there on 30 September. Circular '10 N. Y.' for charges on arrival, no Trinidad despatch handstamp.
TRS13020 25 September 1852	From Port of Spain to Grenada. (1d) blue from the first lithographic printing (SG13), paying local fee, rated 4d on arrival. {Mellor}
TRS13030 25 September 1852	From Port of Spain to Edinburgh, Scotland. (1d) blue from the first lithographic printing (SG13), paying local fee and rated 1s on arrival. {Kanai, CRL (3 March 1993), Addiss}
TRS13040 25 September 1852	From Port of Spain to St. Thomas. (1d) blue from the first lithographic printing (SG13), paying local fee and rated 4d on arrival. {Charlton Henry, Dale Lichtenstein}
TRS03300 25 September 1852	From Port of Spain to St. Thomas, addressed to Schön, Willink & Co., franked with single (1d) deep blue (salvaged) (SG3), cancelled '1' (Type 0.1b). Also charged 4d for the inter-Antillean rate.
TRS05117 27 September 1852	Cover from San Fernando to Barbados bearing a (1d9 grey (SG5) tied by a '2' in a square of bars and rated at '4' in manuscript. {Grosvenor (14 June 2018)}
TRS03310 10 October 1852	From Port of Spain to Greenock, Scotland, addressed to John Neill, arrived on 4 November, 25 days later. A prepaid entire paying the local rate of one penny with a single (1d) deep blue (salvaged) (SG3), rated 1 shilling paid in cash for the Packet rate.
TRS13050 10 October 1852	From Port of Spain to Barbados, (1d) blue from the first lithographic printing (SG13). Stamp cancelled by '1' obliterator (Type 0.1b), manuscript '8'. (Tapling)
TRS13060 10 October 1852	From Port of Spain to St. Thomas. (1d) blue from the first lithographic printing (SG13), paying local fee and rated '8' on arrival, probably being a double weighted letter. {Charlton Henry, Marriott, Pitts}
TRS13070 10 October 1852	From Port of Spain to New York. (1d) blue from the first lithographic printing (SG13). Small circular handstamp '10' for postage due on arrival. {Charlton Henry, Tomasini, Robson Lowe (12 March 1975)}
TRS03320 10 October 1852	From Port of Spain addressed to John Neill, at Greenock. A prepaid entire paying the local rate of one penny franked with a single (1d) blue (salvaged ?) (SG3) cancelled '1' (Type 0.1b) and rated 1 shilling. {Jaffé}
TRS13080 1852	From Port of Spain to Hamburg, Germany. (1d) blue from the first lithographic printing (SG13), paying local fee and rated '3s.3d' for the Packet charges. Indistinct German handwritten rate figures on front.
TRS13090 27 October 1852	From Port of Spain to Greenock, Scotland. (1d) blue from the first lithographic printing (SG13), paying local fee and rated 1 shilling on arrival.

TRS13120 9 November 1852	From Port of Spain to Hamburg, Germany, originating from Ciudad Bolívar (written 1 November). (1d) blue from the first lithographic printing (SG13) tied by a '1' (Type 0.1b). A marginal copy. {Burrus, Caspary}
TRS13130 9 November 1852	From Port of Spain to London, arrived on 10 December. (1d) blue from the first lithographic printing (SG13). {Caspary}
TRS13140 9 November 1852	From Port of Spain to St. Thomas. (1d) blue from the first lithographic printing (SG13), paying local fee and rated '8d' on arrival. {Robson Lowe (27 January 1978)}
TRS13150 9 November 1852	From Port of Spain to Greenock, Scotland, probably a prepaid letter. (1d) blue from the first lithographic printing (SG13), cancelled by clear handstamp with '1' (Type 0.1b). Light vertical filing fold through stamp. {Ramkissoon}
TRS13160 9 November 1852	From Port of Spain to Greenock, Scotland, on large piece. (1d) blue from the first lithographic printing (SG13).
TRS13170 24 November 1852	From Port of Spain to Greenock, Scotland. (1d) blue from the first lithographic printing (SG13) paying local fee and rated '1s' on arrival. Slightly affected at left by a filing crease. {Siegel (23 April 1996), Grosvenor (21 November 2007), Corinphila (22 May 2018)}

Boxed red handstamp 'Colonies/&c Art. 13' for British unpaid letters sent to France. {Ramkissoon}
TRS13180 26 November 1852	From Port of Spain to Greenock, Scotland. (1d) blue from the first lithographic printing (SG13), cut into at bottom, cancelled by oval grid with figure '1'. Stamp paying local fee and rated '1s' on arrival. {Brassler}
