PARCEL POST TO CERTAIN WEST INDIAN COLONIES,
BRITISH GUIANA, JAMAICA, BERMUDA AND
CANADA.

Regulations made by the Governor in Executive Council under
the Post Office Ordinance, Cap. 108.

The following shall be inserted as Regulation 306A
of the Postal Regulations, 1914:—

306A.—(1) The maximum weight for parcels sent for delivery
in the undermentioned places shall be as follows:—

(2) The Rates of Postage on parcels to the above
mentioned places other than Canada shall be as follows:—

For a parcel not over 3 lb in weight	1s.
For a parcel over 3 lb. but not over 7 lb. in weight	2s.
Do. do. 7 lb.	do. 11 lb.	do. ...	3s.
Do. do. 11 lb.	do. 22 lb.	do. ...	6s.

(3) The Rates of Postage on parcels for the Dominion of
Canada shall be as follows:—

For a parcel not exceeding 1 lb. in weight	...	6d.
For each parcel exceeding 1 lb. in weight to the limit of 15 lb.	6d. per lb. or part of a pound.

(4) The size allowed for any such parcel shall be:—

Greatest length	3 feet 6 inches.
Do. and girth combined	6 feet.

Regulations made by the Governor in Executive Council
under the Post Office Ordinance, 1918.

PARCEL POST TO GREAT BRITAIN AND
NORTHERN IRELAND.

1. Regulation 306 of the Postal Regulations dated the 16th day of September, 1914, is hereby revoked and in lieu thereof shall be read the following:—

306. (1) The maximum weight for parcels sent for delivery in Great Britain and Northern Ireland is 22 lbs.

(2) All parcels sent for delivery in Great Britain and Northern Ireland exceeding 11 lbs. in weight shall, if required by His Majesty's Postmaster-General, be collected by the addressee from the normal office of delivery.

(3) The maximum weight for parcels sent to other countries through Great Britain and Northern Ireland is as detailed in the London Post Office Guide.

2. Regulation 4 of the Postal Regulations dated the 15th day of March, 1923, is hereby revoked and in lieu thereof shall be read the following:—

4. The rates of postage on parcels to Great Britain and Northern Ireland shall be as follows:—

For a parcel not over 3 lbs. in weight	2/-
Do. over 3 lbs. but not over 7 lbs. in weight	3/-
Do. „ 7 lbs. do. 11 lbs. do.	4/6
Do. „ 11 lbs. do. 22 lbs. do.	7/-
