

## GOVERNMENT NOTICE No. 30

## TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL UNDER THE  
POST OFFICE ORDINANCE, CH. 36. NO. 1

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Post Office (Amendment) Regulations, 1953, and shall be read as one with the Post Office Regulations, 1938, as from time to time amended, which Regulations as so amended are hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations; and these Regulations shall come into force on the 9th day of February, 1953.

2. The following definition is hereby added to Regulation 2 of the Principal Regulations:—

"(18). The expression 'air mail parcel' means a postal packet which is posted at a Post Office in the Colony as a parcel in accordance with the provisions of these Regulations, or is received at a Post Office in the Colony from abroad by Parcel Post and is conveyed or intended to be conveyed through any part of its course in the post by an air mail service."

3. The following Regulation is hereby added to the Principal Regulations immediately after Regulation 12:—

"12A. There shall be charged and paid on air mail packets the rates of postage set out in the Eighth Schedule to these Regulations."

4. Regulation 47 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by inserting immediately after the word "parcels" occurring therein the words "other than air mail parcels".

5. The following Regulation is hereby added to the Principal Regulations immediately after Regulation 47:—

"47A. There shall be charged and paid on outgoing air mail parcels the rates of postage set out in the Ninth Schedule to these Regulations."

6. The following two Schedules to be denoted respectively Eighth Schedule and Ninth Schedule are hereby added to the Principal Regulations:—

It is proposed to invite Tenders in 1953 for the execution of the following works forming part of the Five-Year Economic Programme of Government.

2. This notice is published with a view to giving contractors who may wish to tender, forward information of the possible work that would be forthcoming from Government this year in the hope contractors would be facilitated in planning the use of materials, labour and equipment, &c., to best advantage.

3. The costs of the works and the dates of commencement are an approximate assessment and should not be regarded as final. Further and complete particulars will appear in the Press when the usual tender notice is published.

*Education Buildings :*

Tranquillity Boys' and Girls' Schools. Extension to each to take 200 more pupils. Estimated Cost \$64,000.00. Tenders to be called for in June.

New Primary School at Arima for 300 pupils. Estimated to cost \$48,000.00. Tenders to be called for in July.

Practical Training Centre at El Socorro. Estimated to cost \$19,000.00. Tenders to be called for in June.

New Primary School at Les Efforts, San Fernando to hold 500 pupils. Estimated to cost \$80,000.00. Tenders to be advertised in July.

New Primary School at Guayaguayare for 250 pupils including a Domestic Science Centre and Headteacher's Quarters. Estimated to cost \$68,000.00. Tenders to be advertised in June.

*Public Buildings :*

A two- or three-storied block of Office Buildings in Treasury Street, Port-of-Spain, to house the Parcels Post, Co-operative Bank, Inland Revenue and other Government Departments. Estimated to cost \$450,000.00. Tenders to be advertised in August.

A new Court House at Chaguanas. Estimated to cost \$60,000.00. Tenders to be advertised in August.

*Police Stations :*

Marine Branch Police Station to house 1 N.C.O. and 137 men. Estimated to cost \$117,000.00. Tenders to be advertised in June.

Guapo Police Station to house 1 N.C.O. and 12 men. Estimated to cost \$25,000.00. Tenders will probably be invited in May.

Quarters for Public Officers will be built by Contract as far as possible. Final 1953 programme has not yet been settled.

*Medical Buildings :*

St. Ann's Mental Hospital. Erection of accommodation for an additional 150 patients, estimated to cost \$45,000.00. Tenders will probably be called for in May.

New 48 bedded Hospital at Sangre Grande estimated to cost \$541,000. It is anticipated that tenders will be called for in May.

Extensions and alterations to Tobago Hospital. This work is estimated to cost \$437,728.00. Tenders will be invited in July.

Health Centre at Marabella, San Fernando. Estimated cost \$20,400. Tenders to be invited in August.
