THE POST OFFICE ORDINANCE, CH. 36. No. 1.

REGULATIONS

Made by the Governor in Council under section 71 of the Post Office Ordinance

THE POST OFFICE (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1956

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Post Office (Amendment) Regulations, 1956 and shall be read as one with the Post Office Regulations, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations.
- 2. The following regulation is hereby substituted for regulation 131 of the Principal Regulations:—

"Limit for inland money order shall be issued for a sum exceeding two hundred dollars."
